## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING #2

The City of Marysville intends to submit an application to the Ohio Department of Development on June 26, 2009 for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program, a federally funded program administered by the State of Ohio. The City is eligible for \$59,000 of Fiscal Year 2009 CDBG Formula grant funds, provided the city meets applicable program requirements.

The second and last public hearing will be held at 7:00 p.m. on May 28, 2009 at City Hall in City Council Chambers, located at 125 East Sixth Street, to provide citizens with pertinent information about the CDBG program, including an explanation of eligible activities and program requirements. The CDBG program can fund a broad range of activities including economic development, street improvements, water supply, drainage and sanitary sewer improvements, park improvements, demolition of unsafe structures, and rehabilitation of housing and neighborhood facilities. The activities must be designed to primarily benefit low-to moderate-income residents, aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight, or meet an urgent need of the community.

The City proposes to submit an application for \$59,000 to assist in the financing of the TIER II Downtown Revitalization Grant, which the City received in December 2008. The TIER II Downtown Revitalization Grant gives financial assistance to infrastructure and building renovations in a designated blighted portion of Historic Uptown Marysville.
