

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO RECYCLE?

- Recycling conserves natural resources.
- Recycling reduces pollution.
- Recycling conserves landfill space.
- Recycling saves energy.
- Recycling in a Pay As You Throw program saves you money!



MISCELLANEOUS

- All recycling/trash will be picked up between 6am & 5pm.
- If your normal recycling/trash day is a holiday, your pickup will be the next day.
- The holidays observed are New's Year Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.

WHO CAN RECYCLE?...

All residents are encouraged to recycle through Pay As You Throw program. This program is for residents who are serviced by the District.

- You may IDENTIFY your RECYCLING BIN. Using a permanent marker, put your address on the side of your box.
- Set out your RECYCLING BIN on the morning (before 6am) of your regular collection day to discourage scavenging, container theft, and litter.
- Get a replacement (see box below) if your container is lost, stolen or damaged.

Leave the RECYCLING BIN for the next resident. The RECYCLING BIN is provided free for your use, but remains the property of the Solid Waste District

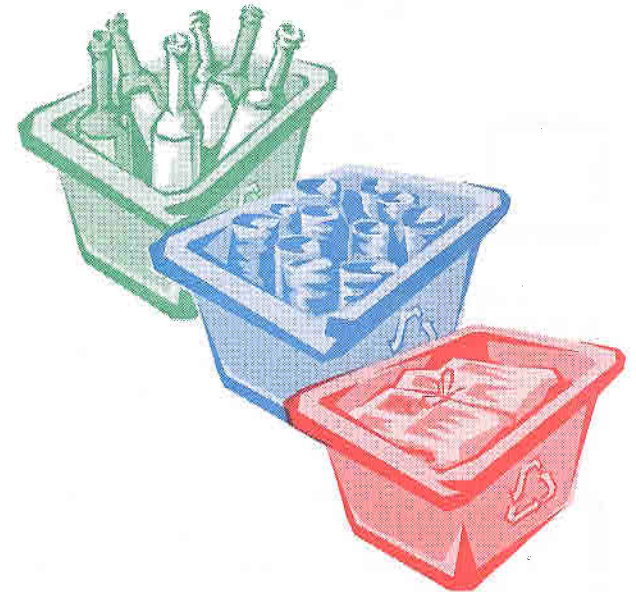

HOW & WHAT TO RECYCLE?

3 QUICK & EASY STEPS

1

Put the RECYCLING BIN next to your waste basket, under the sink, in a closet, by the door or wherever most convenient for you. The RECYCLING BIN provides clean, convenient storage for your recyclables, and keeps them from being contaminated by other garbage and trash.

2

Prepare your recyclables as directed and place in the RECYCLING BIN. If you have more recyclables than the RECYCLING BIN will hold, put them into open or clearly marked bags or other containers. If you consistently need more space, please call the information number (on back) for another recycling bin.

3

Take the RECYCLING BIN and the trash bags/cans to the curb by 6:00am on the morning of your trash collection day. Be sure the RECYCLING BIN can be easily seen by the collection crew. Please remove the RECYCLING BIN from the curb as soon as possible after it is emptied, but no later than 7:00pm on the day of pick up.

Curbside Recycling

Please follow the simple guidelines in preparing items for recycling. Recyclables improperly prepared or mixed with trash will not be picked up. Only the items listed can be collected curbside. If you miss a curbside collection day, you may save the recyclables for the next week.

ALL METAL FOOD & BEVERAGE CANS



- Rinse CLEAN
- Please drain completely
- Cans may be flattened to save space.
- Labels can be left on.

PAPER

**NEWSPAPER WITH AD SLICKS—
MAGAZINES—CEREAL BOXES—
TELEPHONE BOOKS— MAIL—
OFFICE PAPER—KRAFT PAPER
(BROWN PAPER GROCERY)**

- Stack loose or place in a paper bag(s)
- Newspaper inserts are OK.
- Corrugated Cardboard boxes (no larger than 2' x 2'- must fit in or on top of bin)
- DO NOT set out paper on wet, rainy days. Wet paper CANNOT be recycled. Save for sunny days.



PLASTIC

BOTTLES—



**SOFT DRINK - MILK & WATER JUGS -
DETERGENT, SOFTENER &
BLEACH**

- Only plastic bottles with the #1 or #2 symbol found on the bottom
- Rinse CLEAN
- NO PLASTIC BAGS, STYROFOAM, DELI CONTAINERS, TOYS, MOTOR OIL CONTAINERS, BUCKETS, LIDS, BUTTER TUBS, PLASTICS #3-#7, PLANT TRAYS
- *You may flatten plastics to save space.*



GLASS FOOD

JARS & BOTTLES

- Remove caps & lids
- Rinse CLEAN
- Paper labels do not have to be removed.
- NO MIRRORS, CERAMICS, LIGHT BULBS, WINDOW GLASS, PYREX HEAT RESISTANT GLASS, CHINA OR DISHES
- ONLY clear, green and brown glass
- Labels can be left on.
