2006 was a year of change for the canine unit. Indi officially retired after over nine years of productive service. He ended his career with 224 criminal arrests. Indi is doing well and enjoying retirement at my home.

Our canine program was given donations from Union Rural Electric and the VFW. These donation allowed our department to purchase Indi's replacement, Khan. In April, Khan and I started our training. This was an exciting time for me because I got to train him from the start. After three months of intense training, Khan and I took to the streets. In September, Khan and I were given a donation from Cub Scout Pack #684. They raised enough money to purchase Khan a bullet proof vest. We would like to thank each of the scouts and the people who support them in the fund raiser.



During 2006, Khan and I responded to 43 calls for service. These calls for service resulted in the arrest of 6 suspects.

Khan and I have made numerous appearances in the community including demstrations at Creekview Elementry School, Trinity Lutheran School, and at the Otter Run Cub Scout Camp.

I have high expectations for Khan and I in 2007. Khan and I will work diligently to make Marysville a safer community.
